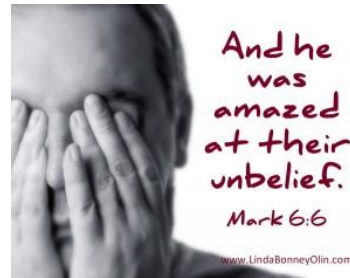

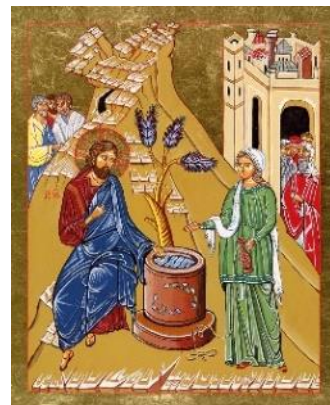


Because of lack of faith Jesus cannot work miracles when he returned to his home in, Nazareth. Why not?

Jesus often said to people whom he had healed, "your faith has saved you." The word "faith" as Jesus used it can best be described as a personal act, "the free response of the human person to the initiative of God who reveals himself". It is a relationship between the believer and Jesus that is steeped in trust and love. The deepest meaning of faith is this: to have a mutual relationship with God. That is, to receive God's love and respond to it. A failure in faith is like closing or even locking the doors to our hearts.

If this makes some sense to you, then you will see why Jesus said "your faith has saved you." If faith is a word for a person's relation to Jesus, the curing happens because they have a real, mutual relationship of trust and love.
